Even if I go through the deepest darkness, I will not be afraid, LORD, for you are with me.


Your shepherd's rod and staff protect me.

In the poem David wrote "God is my shepherd". What does a shepherd do?


God looks after us like a shepherd looks after his sheep. Draw a sheep in the middle of your piece of your piece of paper.

Add some green grass to your picture.




We pray:

Draw a fence around your sheep to remember how God looks after us.




We pray:
